5. We need a full name and a link to your Flickr account, website, or email for photo credit. Photo credit is only offered for photos appearing on the cover or in an article.
6. Photos will not be given a caption unless your pet appears on the cover of the magazine or if they are selected as the rescued pet of the month. (If your pet is a rescue, please tag it as rescued)
7. Photos must be 700px on their largest side.
